What is this product?

This product is a unit of a mutual fund qualifying as an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities (UCITS).

This sub-fund has no maturity date. However, the management company may decide to close the sub-fund under certain circumstances.

The sub-fund aims to generate a long-term capital appreciation and dividends by investing in companies in Asia.

In order to achieve its objective, the sub-fund may invest in equity or equity-related securities of companies domiciled in Asia (including but not limited to China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, South Korea, Singapore,India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, the Philippines, Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia and Myanmar).

The sub-fund will normally not invest in companies domiciled in Japan.

The sub-fund invests in particular in companies that in the opinion of the Investment Manager are expected to have a high and sustainable dividend yield supported by sustainable growth in revenues and The sub-fund is aiming at a diversified portfolio, with no particular focus on an industry or capitalization of companies.

For its investments in equities or equity-related securities of companies domiciled in China, the sub-fund may invest its assets in China B-Shares, China H-Shares and up to 30% of its net assets in China A-Shares listed on mainland exchanges of Shanghai and Shenzhen. The sub-fund will invest and have direct access to certain eligible China A-Shares via the Stock Connect.

The sub-fund may invest in derivative instruments in order to mitigate risks.

The sub-fund may invest in any equity-related instrument on any regulated market in any OECD country outside Asia as long as a significant portion of the company's assets are based in Asia or a significant portion of the revenues are derived from Asia.

Benchmark: The portfolio is actively managed on a discretionary basis without reference to a benchmark.

Intended retail investor

The sub-fund is offered to investors who may have basic or no knowledge and experience of investing in financial markets and also experienced investors. An investment in the sub-fund is designated to be a medium term investment and the investment horizon should ideally be at least three to five years. Investors should not expect to obtain short-term gains from such investment.

Other information

Depositary: Skandinaviska Enskilda Banken. AB (publ) - Luxembourg

Dividend income: This class is a capitalisation class meaning that income is reinvested.

Conversion right: The investor has the right to convert his investment in units in one sub-fund for units in the same sub-fund or in another sub-fund. The investor can obtain information about how to convert in the prospectus of the fund.

Segregation: The assets and liabilities of a sub-fund are segregated pursuant to the law so that the commitments and liabilities of one subfund do not affect the other sub-funds.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact our capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You may receive payments in a currency that differs from your reference currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

What happens if FundRock Management Company S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company, as the manufacturer of this product has no obligation to pay out since the product design does not contemplate any such payment being made. However, investors may suffer loss if the sub-fund or the depositary is unable to pay out. There is no compensation or guarantee scheme in place which may offset, all or any, of this loss.

What are the costs?

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period: 5 years
